Tuttle North and South Exterior Site Rehabilitation

The Tuttle Athletics Complex at SUNY Brockport, originally constructed in the 1960s, underwent a major renovation of its two original buildings as part of a capital improvements project with the State University Construction Fund. The facility's East and West Entry areas were completely redesigned to improve function and aesthetic. Building envelope improvements and site repairs were also implemented.

The new site layout at the facility's main entryway provided direct physical and visual access to the common entry point for the buildings. More open and secure entryways were designed to access the existing locker rooms and weight rooms on the west side of Tuttle South as well.

The circulation of athletes, service vehicles, and equipment was greatly improved. A covered connector walkway between Tuttle North and Tuttle South was added, and improvements were made to the preexisting, lower level, connector tunnel.

The loading dock area and entryway were relocated to the opposite side of the courtyard. This diminished the loading dock's prominence and provided a more controlled access point. The existing metal egress stairs at the south face of the Tuttle South Gymnasium were removed and replaced with larger concrete stairs for code compliance. Overall, the redesign created visual openness and a more appealing environment for campus residents and visitors.
