Manley Field House Athletic Complex Site Improvements

KHH was chosen to design site improvements to the Manley Field House Athletic Complex. The new football entrance captures the spirit and pride of SU football fans and the dedication wall creates a sense of nostalgia while honoring past captains and coaches.



The central element is the engraved dedication wall. The wall has a full depth concrete foundation and is capped with radius granite coping. A section of the inside vertical wall was constructed with recessed granite panels used for engraving names of past and future captains, coaches, and notable events. The street side of the wall with raised lettering was constructed of formed concrete with vertical and horizontal rustication.

Plants around the dedication plaza consist of low growing evergreen shrubs with medium sized deciduous trees. An annual flower bed is centered on the dedication wall.

The concrete sidewalk at the entrance to the building was replaced with Tudor-finished concrete pavers. Above this, an arch was constructed of poured-in-place concrete. This aesthetic gateway provides screening.

A new pedestrian walkway extends from the Manley South Parking Lot to the north side of Manley and connects to the existing walkways. The coach's parking area was re-striped and the existing curb islands were modified with a planting area edged with a granite curb. These new walkways provide access for winter maintenance vehicles and ample room for guests walking to the game.
